## THE COLLECTIONS



Unique, fresh, distinct, moving, authentic, powerful, and smart. All are words used to describe Miller's approach to iconographal image and text.


The viewer is invited into a particular type of graphic storytelling called narrative iconography. This storytelling is done through images, colors, and shapes. The storytelling offered here invites the reader to engage with the story in response to what you see as you ponder the image. The thrity four icons engage us first visually, then emotionally, mindfully, and imaginatively.

Mary Jane Miller brings to this ancient art form both a deep understanding of and love for the icon tradition of eastern Christianity and a modern sensibility of expression. The images are visual writings of the story of Jesus, his miracles and principle events that lead to liturgy.

Perhaps some of Miller's work is rebellious, placing women in the story at the Last Supper, Pentecost and the foot washing. She does not create her images without thought and reflection. Expect some subconscious squirming when the traditional image is not the one we've been conditioned to expect, however the beauty is lavish and consistent.






#2 TITLE: THE ULTIMA SUPPER 18" x 24" egg tempera and 23kt gold




#3 TITLE: MARY AND CHRIST AT THE TOMB 18" x 24" egg tempera and 23kt gold
































#23 TITLE: WOMEN AT THE TOMB 12x 16" egg tempera and repouse




#24 TITLE: THE POOL OF BATHESDA 12 x 16" egg tempera and repouse




#25 TITLE: CASTING OUT DEMONS12 x 16" egg tempera and repouse






#27 TITLE: PETER WALKS ON WATER 12 x 16" egg tempera and repouse






